Sermon Summary

Pharoah the king of Egypt was disturbed after he dreamed that seven fat cows were destroyed by seven puny cows and seven good ears of corn were devoured by seven bad ears of corn. He sent for all the Egyptian magicians and wise men, but they were unable to interpret Pharoah's dream. Then Pharoah's butler remembered that Joseph, a Hebrew who was being held in the Egyptian prison, was skilled at interpreting dreams so the king sent for Joseph. When he stands before the King Joseph lets them know that it was his God who gave the ability to interpret dreams and after he hears the dream, Joseph interprets the dream and gives the king a plan that would ensure they would survive the bad times they would soon face.

We are living in unpredictable and precarious times; the indicators vary but more than likely there will be economic challenges and societal unrest to negotiate in the near future, so it's (Now!) a good time to get ready. The Great Depression (1929-1939) caught many people unprepared for the 10 years of suffering, there were people who starved and others who kill themselves because the pain and suffering were so hard. Joseph's plan saved both the Egyptians and his own people because the plan was to get ready by storing commodities/resources while times are good (fat cows) knowing that bad days (lean cows) are coming. How long can you/your family survive if all the banks fail (2008-2009) or credit cards or electronic accounts go dark and become unavailable? It's a good Time to get Ready.


Annual Spring Festival


Holy Week - Bible Bowl Game Night



March is Self-Harm Awareness Month

Self-Harm Awarness

- Definition and Prevalence:
 - Self-harm is the intentional act of hurting oneself, a symptom of severe emotional distress.
 - It's prevalent, especially among teenage girls, with rates significantly increasing in recent years.
- Forms of Self-Harm:
 - Various methods are described, including cutting, scratching, burning, and selfhitting.
- Reasons for Self-Harm:
 - It stems from poor coping skills and difficulty managing emotions.
 - Individuals may use it to regulate emotions, seek control, or express internal
 - pain.
- Risk Factors and Warning Signs:
 - Adolescence, peer influence, trauma, mental health issues, and substance use are identified as risk factors.
 - Physical signs (scars, wounds) and behavioral/emotional changes are listed as warning signs.
- Suicide Risk:
 - While not always a suicide attempt, self-harm increases the risk of suicide.
- Prevention and Intervention:
 - Strategies for prevention include fostering healthy coping skills, promoting social connection, and raising awareness.
 - Guidance is provided on how to help someone who self-harms, emphasizing support and professional help.
- Emergency Help:
 - Instructions are given for when to seek immediate medical or mental health assistance, including suicide hotline numbers.


NEW!! Food Pantry Hours


